(B) To consider to recommend to request to Government of Assam for Concurrence of the Teaching Positions of the Centres for Studies, Dibrugarh University

**Discussion:** 

As recommended by the 123<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Under Graduate Board held on 02.03.2021, the Council discussed the matter of requesting the Government of Assam for concurrence of the teaching positions in the various Centres for Studies, Dibrugarh University. The Council finally decided to recommend the same to the Executive Council for necessary correspondence with the Government for getting the financial concurrence of the teaching positions of different academic programmes offered by the Centres for Studies. The Council also recommended to the Executive Council to request the Government for establishment of new departments to conduct the various academic programmes presently offered by the Centres for Studies. The following resolutions were adopted accordingly -

  - (D) To consider the provision for allotment of two Dibrugarh University Research Fellowships in a year to the DRC in Life Sciences.
- **Discussion:** As recommended by the 12<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Research Council held on 04.03.2021, the Joint Registrar (Academic) placed the matter regarding the provision for allotment of two Dibrugarh University Research Fellowships (one for Zoology and another for Botany) in a year to the DRC in Life Sciences. The Council discussed the matter and decided to approve it. The following resolution was adopted accordingly-
- Resolution No. 19: Resolved that as recommended by the 12<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Research Council held on 04.03.2021, necessary provision be created for allotment of two Dibrugarh University Research Fellowships in a year to the DRC in Life Sciences, one for the eligible candidate from M.Sc. in Botany and another to the eligible candidate from the M. Sc. in Zoology.
- (E) To consider necessary budgetary provision for Instrument Operators of the Central Sophisticated Instrumentation Centre (CSIC), Dibrugarh University.
- **Discussion :** The Registrar placed the matter before the Council and explained the need for necessary budgetary provision for appointment of two Instrument Operators in the Central Sophisticated Instrumentation Centre (CSIC), Dibrugarh University for smooth running. The Council discussed the matter decided to recommend to the Executive Council for necessary approval and needful. The following resolution was adopted accordingly-

- **Discussion:** As recommended by the 11<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Research Council held on 28.10.2020, the Joint Registrar (Academic) placed the draft of the Dibrugarh University Regulation for the D.Sc. D.Litt. Programme. The Council discussed the matter thoroughly and adopted the following Resolution to approve the same-
- Resolution No. 21: Resolved that as recommended by the 11<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Research Council held on 28.10.2020, the draft of the Dibrugarh University

Regulations for the D.Sc. D.Litt. Programmes of Dibrugarh University be approved.

(G) Matter of Ratification for e-submission of Ph. D. Theses and conducting the Viva-Voce Examinations in online mode.

**Discussion:** The Joint Registrar (Academic) placed the matter for ratification which was issued vide memo No. DU/JR-A/6-1/20/329 dated 08.05.2020 for esubmission of Ph.D. Theses and conducting the Viva-Voce Examinations in online mode under report to the Research Council and Academic Council. The Council noted the same. The following resolution was adopted accordingly-

Resolution No. 22: Resolved that the Notification approved by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, D.U. for e-submission of Ph.D. Theses and conducting the Viva-Voce Examinations in online mode (notified vide DU/JR-A/6-1/20/329 dated 08.05.2020) as per the directive of Government of India due to COVID-19 pandemic be noted and ratified.

Resolved further that the same provision be continued until further notification in this regard.

- (H)To consider the introduction of UGC prescribed 2 Credit Audit Course on Research and Publication Ethics in the Ph.D. and M. Phil Course Work.
- **Discussion:** The Joint Registrar (Academic) placed the matter before the Council regarding the introduction of the UGC prescribed 2 Credit Audit Course on Research and Publication Ethics in the Ph.D. and M. Phil Course Work. The Council discussed and approved the matter and accordingly following resolution was adopted-
- Resolution No. 23: Resolved that introduction of the UGC prescribed 2 Credit Audit Course on Research and Publication Ethics be introduced in the Ph.D. and M. Phil Course Work across the disciplines along with the present Course Structure w.e.f. 2020-2021 academic session.

Resolved further that the concerned Departments/ Centres for Studies/ Colleges offering the Ph.D. programmes of Dibrugarh University be advised to do the needful for its implementation.

Further resolved that the students be allowed to pursue the UGC prescribed 2 Credit Audit Course on Research and Publication Ethics as MOOCs also.

- (I) To consider the Policy for Publication of Ph.D. Theses by intending scholars.
- **Discussion:** The Joint Registrar (Academic) apprised the matter to consider the Policy for Publication of Ph.D. Theses by intending scholars and the Council discussed the matter and accordingly following resolution was adopted-
- Resolution No. 24: Resolved that the Policy for Publication of Ph.D. Theses by intending scholars be reviewed and a convenient policy be adopted.

Resolved further that Prof. D. Chetia, Dean, R & D, Dibrugarh University be requested to work out a Policy for Publication of Ph. D. Theses by intending scholars.

- (J) To consider recommendations from the meeting of the Academic Planning Committee held on 17.12.2020.
- Discussion: As recommended by the Academic Planning Committee held on 17.12.20 the Joint Registrar (Academic) placed the Academic Calendars for the (i) Teaching Departments, Centres of Studies and DUIET of Dibrugarh University for the period from January, 2021 to August, 2021 and (ii) General Degree Colleges/ Institutes affiliated to/ permitted by Dibrugarh University for the period from January, 2021 to August, 2021 which were approved by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, D.U. under report to the Academic Council and the Executive Council, Dibrugarh University and notified vide memo No. DU/DR-A/APC/20/1093 dated 21.12.2020 and DU/DR-A/APC/20/1094. The Council notated and ratified accordingly and following resolution was adopted-
- Resolution No. 25: Resolved that the Academic Calendars of 2021 along with its subsequent notifications notified under report to the Academic Council be noted and ratified.
  - (K) To examine the eligibility criteria for the posts of Assistant Professors in Botany and Zoology in view of the M.Sc. Degrees in subjects like Biotechnology, Microbiology, Molecular Biology, etc.
- Discussion: As recommended by the Departmental Management Committee of Life Sciences, Dibrugarh University the Council observed that the M.Sc. Degrees in the subjects like Biotechnology, Microbiology, Molecular Biology, etc. cannot be considered as concerned subjects for the post of Assistant Professor in Botany and Assistant Professor in Zoology in the degree colleges affiliated to Dibrugarh University The Council adopted the following resolution accordingly -
- Resolution No. 26: Resolved that as recommended by the Departmental Management Committee of Life Sciences, Dibrugarh University, it is ascertained that the M.Sc. Degrees in subjects like Biotechnology, Microbiology, Molecular Biology, etc. cannot be considered as concerned subjects for the post Assistant Professor in Botany and Assistant Professor in Zoology in the degree colleges affiliated to Dibrugarh University.
  - (L) To consider for Awarding the B.Sc. Degree to the successful candidates in the Dibrugarh University for the Five-Year Integrated M.Sc. in Physics Programme.
- **Discussion**: As recommended by the Board of Studies in Physics, Dibrugarh University, the proposal for the provisions for Awarding the B. Sc. Degree to the candidate, who have successfully completed his/ her Course of Studies upto Sixth Semester in the Five-Year Integrated M.Sc. in Physics Programme was placed before the Council for consideration. The Council discussed the matter and decided to approve the same. The following resolution was adopted accordlingly.
- Resolution No. 27: Resolved that as recommended by the Board of Studies in Physics, Dibrugarh University, necessary provisions be created for Awarding

the B.Sc. Degree to the successful candidates in the Dibrugarh University Regulations for the Five-Year Integrated M.Sc.in Physics Programme as below-

## (M) To consider the drafts of Policies submitted by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Dibrugarh University.

Discussion: As submitted by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Dibrugarh University the Joint Registrar (Academic), placed before the Council the following drafts of the Policies for consideration.

(O)To consider for offering SWAYAM Courses in the various Post Graduate Academic Programmes of the University.

**Discussion**: The Joint Registrar (Academic) placed before the Council the matter of offering of the UGC- SWAYAM Courses in the various Post Graduate Academic Programmes of the University. The Council discussed from all aspects of it and adopted the following resolution-

Resolution No. 30: Resolved that necessary actions be taken for offering the SWAYAM Courses in the various Post Graduate Academic Programmes of the University-

- a) To encourage students to enroll themselves in the SWAYAM Courses as Generic Elective (GE) Course and Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) as per the New Dibrugarh University Regulations for the Post Graduate Programmes in the Choice-Based Credit System, 2018 (as amended) from 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester onwards w.e.f. 2020-2021 session.
- b) To request the concerned Heads of the Departments/ Chairpersons of the Centres of Studies to designate a MOOCs Facilitator to guide the students throughout the Course.
- c) To constitute a SWAYAM Advisory Committee be constituted to look after the MOOC's matters.
- d) The SWAYAM Advisory Committee be entrusted the responsibility of selecting the MOOCs for the Post Graduate Students from time to time.
- e) To take necessary action for transferring the Credits earned by the students through SWAYAM courses during his/her study in the concerned Semester at Dibrugarh University reflected in the SGPA/CGPA.
- f) The 'Modalities for Credit Transfer' be prepared and the concerned Regulations be amended accordingly.
- g) To notify that the ccurses chosen from the SWAYAM Platform opted as GE must be atleast of 4 Credits and AEC of 2 Credits.

As there was no other matter for discussion, the meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the Chair.
