

Syllabus for Certificate Course in Deori Language as approved by the Board of Studies in Deori, the meeting held on 15 October 2015 at Siukapha Bhavan, Centre for Studies in Language, Dibrugarh University

The course known as **Certificate Course in Deori Language** which is primarily a certificate course of sixth month duration and the course aims at imparting of spoken skill on the Deori language among the non- Deori speakers and along with the skill of writing and translation from other languages into Deori and vice versa.. The course consists of 3 (three) papers having 100 marks in each paper.

In the entire course attention will be given on interaction on the lessons to make the course more effective, easily intelligible, functional and practical. Paper wise distribution of the course contents is as follows.

Paper-I

The fundamental objective of this paper is to make aware of the phonological and lexical typology and their pronunciation in a scientific method.

Unit-1: Introduction to the language and Introduction to alphabets and phonemes, special phonological features of the language.

Unit-2: Articulation of phonemes: vowel and consonant phonemes

Unit-3: Vocabulary of the language and properly articulation of different words

Unit-4: Introduction to word typology: simple, compound and complex typology

Exercise: Writing of alphabets, writing of spelling of different words consisting of simple, compound and complex type

Paper-II

This paper attempts to discuss and to make verbal and communicative exercise on the following grammatical categories and its principal elements.

Unit-1: Application of case-markers

Unit-2: Application of numerals and numeral classifiers

Unit-3: Gender distinction and number

Unit-4: Application of pronouns

Exercise: Orthographical use and phonological articulation of case-markers, numerals, classifiers, gender and plural markers, articulation of tense-markers etc.

Paper-III

This paper aims at developing creative skill along with the translation competence.

Unit-1: Translation from other languages into Deori (Assamese to Deori)

Unit-2: Translation from Deori into other languages

Unit-3: Conversation in Deori and reading from the texts

Unit-4: Creative writing

Exercise: Reading and writing
