



The Guidelines for Conducting Examinations for the Differently/ Specially Abled Candidates, Dibrugarh University

(Notified vide Memo No. DU/DR-A/6-1/18/ 1438 dated 30.11.2018)

A. Eligibility:

Blind by birth, Blind later on due to accident or illness, non functioning of certain motor nerves since birth, non functioning of certain motor nerves due to accident or illness, physically handicapped.

N.B.: The candidates must apply to the Controller of Examinations, D.U., through proper channel (Principal/HoD of the College/ Department, etc.) for consideration and must submit medical certificate issued by competent medical person not below the rank of the Joint Director of Health Services of the district concerned.

B. Allowable qualifications of scribes/ Amanuensis

The qualification of the scribes/ amanuensis/ readers/Lab assistant(s) sought by a candidate must be at least **one step (one year)** below the qualification of the candidate taking examination **preferably from the same stream/subject** and must not be related to the candidate.

N.B.: Candidates must submit documentary proof(s) in respect of the qualification of the scribes/ amanuensis (*along with the sample handwritings*) and the same must be approved by the Controller of Examination, D.U.

C. Compensatory Time

(a) Candidates with disability who avail the assistance of scribes/ amanuensis /writer/helper/readers/Lab assistant shall be entitled for compensation time of maximum 20(twenty) minutes per hour of the examination.

(b) Candidates with disability who do not avail the assistance of scribes/ amanuensis /writer/helper/readers/Lab assistant shall be entitled for minimum compensation time of 1(one) hour for writing examination of three hours duration and the compensation time maybe extended further on merit on a case by case basis.

D. Separate Room for Examination and Use of Device

Separate examination room may be allowed to the differently abled candidates if needed. The candidates may also be allowed to use talking calculators if seems to be necessary.
