

## COVID-19 Updates

### Re-opening of L.N.B. Library on Unlock Period started from June 1, 2020

The L.N.B. Library has re-opened on June 1, 2020 as Unlock-I phase with a few changes/guidelines for the visitors to follow. Please read the update below:

1. The Library will remain open only in one shift i.e. **9:30am to 5:00pm** in all working days with limited staff to reduce exposure to COVID-19
2. Library services for extended period such as 5:30pm to 9:00pm in all working regular days including Saturdays and Sundays are suspended to reduce risk of COVID-19 infection.
1. The library has made efforts to reduce exposure to COVID-19, but the risk of infection cannot be eliminated! To further reduce your risk, consider using curbside service (**curbside dropping of all returned books**) and **online** resources.
2. All face-to-face library services are converted to **social distancing** mode. To reduce your risk, consider social distancing (**at least 6 feet**) strictly.
3. Using **face mask** is compulsory inside the library to reduce your risk of exposure to COVID-19.
4. **Washing hands** with soap or **Use of sanitizer** before entering into the library is compulsory by all (Staff as well as Visitors)
5. Emergency Services are open only for Research Scholars and Faculty Members; UG/PG students are advised to visit **library portal for open access resources**.
6. The above guidelines/restrictions will be changed time to time in accordance with the latest guidelines to be published from the Govt./DU authority.
