Online Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission into the MCA programme for the Academic Session 2020-2021 in the following institute:

A. MCA: 2 year Post Graduate Programme

Eligibility:

Graduate in any discipline with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks having Mathematics as one of the subjects in 10+2 *or at graduate level, wherein pass mark is a must. **Candidates appearing in Bachelor's Degree final examination have to submit the total aggregate mark till 5th Semester.** Such candidates have to complete the Bachelor degree before the end semester examination of the 1st semester. Relaxation of 5% marks will be given to the candidates of reserved categories.

Admission Procedure:

There will be an online test for MCAT (MCA Common Admission Test). 50% weightage will be given MCAT Score and 50% weightage will be given to Degree Percentage. Candidates qualifying the entrance test shall be admitted to the programme solely from the merit list prepared from the entrance results provided that the eligibility criteria prescribed above are fulfilled.

Important Note: The University shall not verify the eligibility of a candidate at the time of

receiving their Application Forms. The candidates not fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria shall not be debarred from appearing the MCA Common Admission Test, 2020.

However, the candidate who clears the entrance shall not be considered at the time of admission to the MCA Programme conducted by Dibrugarh University and its affiliated colleges if he / she fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria. Hence, the intending candidates are requested to ensure themselves regarding fulfillment of the minimum eligibility for admission into the MCA Programme.

Eligibility for Admission:

Graduate in any stream with at least 40% marks in aggregate. Relaxation of 5% marks will be given to the candidates of reserved categories.

Admission Procedure:

Candidates eligible for admission shall be selected on merit basis. The merit list will be displayed at the Office of Centre for Computer Science and Applications, D.U. and in the websites: www.dibru.ac.in and www.ccsdu.in on **20th November, 2020**

How to apply:

The intending candidates need to apply online through the “Online Application Submission” portal of Dibrugarh University which is available at www.dibru.online from **25th October, 2020**. The application fee of **Rs. 500/-** is payable at the time of applying online through Debit Card/ Credit Card/ Internet Banking. On successful submission of the Application, an Acknowledgement Slip with

“SUCCESS” status will be generated. Candidates are advised to download and print the Acknowledgement Slip along with the submitted Application Form for the future references. Hence, the intending candidates are requested to ensure themselves regarding fulfillment of the minimum eligibility for admission to the PGDCA Programme.
