Online Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission into the MCA programme for the Academic Session 2021-2022 in the following institute:

A. MCA: 2 year Post Graduate Programme

Eligibility:

Graduate in any discipline with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks having Mathematics as one of the subjects in 10+2 *or at graduate level, wherein pass mark is a must. **Candidates appearing in Bachelor's Degree final examination have to submit the total aggregate mark till 4th/5th Semester.** Such candidates have to complete the Bachelor degree before the end semester examination of the 1st semester. Relaxation of 5% marks will be given to the candidates of reserved categories.

Admission Procedure:

Candidates will have to appear in the **MCA Common Admission Test (MCAT)** at the following Centres:

- Centre for Computer Science and Applications, Dibrugarh University
- NERIM, Guwahati
- J.B. College (Autonomous), Jorhat

The Date and Time of the Test shall be notified in the website- www.dibru.ac.in later on.

Candidates qualifying the MCAT shall be admitted to the programme solely from the merit list prepared from the MCAT results provided that the eligibility criteria prescribed above are fulfilled.

Pattern of the MCAT:

Note:

- i) The question paper will be of Multiple Choice Objective type.
- ii) There will be no negative marks for wrong answers.
- iii) The question paper will be set in English language only.

Important Note:

- The University shall not verify the eligibility of a candidate at the time of receiving their Application Forms. The candidates not fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria shall not be debarred from appearing the MCA Common Admission Test, 2021. However, the candidate who clears the entrance shall not be considered at the time of admission to the MCA Programme conducted by Dibrugarh University and its affiliated colleges if he / she fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria. Hence, the intending candidates are requested to ensure themselves regarding fulfillment of the minimum eligibility for admission into the MCA Programme.
- Student should bring his/her valid identity proof on the date of MCAT.
