



"Dibrugarh University of Engineering and Technology organizes Diwali each year. The celebrations include lighting lamps and cracking fireworks.


ENVIRONMENT DAY, 2021

Students interested in entrepreneurship and willing to startup were provided a platform to present their ideas and get professional training.


Student training on future skill technologies from 22nd Feb to 6th March 2021

The objective of the training was to make the UG students of TEQUIP institutions industry ready for meeting demands in "Data Science and Analytics".


