Notification inviting Nominations for the Best Teacher Awards - 2023 of Dibrugarh University

Nominations (self-nominations accepted) are invited including self-nominations, from eligible Assistant Professors and Associate Professors across all faculties for "The Best Teacher Award - 2023" in the following distinct categories:

- (i) The Best Assistant Professor from the faculties of Science and Engineering, Earth Sciences and Energy, and Life Sciences.
- (ii) The Best Assistant Professor from the faculties of Humanities and Law, Social Sciences, Education, and Commerce and Management Science.
- (iii) The Best Associate Professor/Professor from the faculties of Science and Engineering, Earth Sciences and Energy, and Life Sciences.
- (iv) The Best Associate Professor/Professor from the faculties of Humanities and Law, Social Sciences, Education, and Commerce and Management Science.

The "Best Teacher Award" at Dibrugarh University is a prestigious program that has been introduced in 2023. The primary goal of this initiative is to recognize and honor outstanding teachers, providing them with the encouragement and incentives to continue excelling in their roles. The award includes a commemorative memento and a certificate, symbolizing the appreciation for the recipient's dedication and hard work. Each year, on September 5, coinciding with National Teachers' Day, the award will be bestowed upon the selected teacher(s) who have demonstrated exceptional teaching prowess and commitment to their profession.

For the selection of an awardee of the award following eligibility criteria and evaluation parameters will be followed:

Eligibility Criteria

- (i) A regular teacher serving in the Dibrugarh University for at least 5 years, can apply for the award.
- (ii) Candidates who have already received this award earlier, shall not be eligible to apply again.
- (iii) Age limit should not cross 40 for the Assistant Professor and 50 for the Associate Professor on the last day of application.

Evaluation Parameters/Components

Applications will be evaluated on the basis of the following four parameters/components.

- (i) Research contribution (50% weight)
- (ii) Teaching activities (30% weight)
- (iii) Administrative Responsibilities (10% weight)
- (iv) Co- Academic Activities (10 % weight)

Evaluation of parameters/components should be taken into consideration for the last three years of the applicants as a permanent faculty with Dibrugarh University affiliation.

The score division procedures for the research papers and books/chapters: **Two authors:** 70% of total value of publication for each author. **More than two authors:** 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors. **Same procedure** will be applicable for division of score in respect of Patent and Policy documents etc.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor.

Parameters/Components	Score submitted by an applicant	Score awarded to the applicant after applying respective weights
Research Contribution	120	60
Teaching Activities	60	18
Administrative Responsibilities	30	3
Co-Academic Activities	20	2
Total/Final	220	83

Thus, the final score of the candidate is 83/220.
