Young people (aged 15-29) constitute almost 40 Crore and represent one-third of India's population. It is generally acknowledged that a significant proportion of Youth are exposed to high-risk behaviour or unwanted sexual activity. It is estimated that over 35 percent of all reported HIV incidences in India occur among young people (aged 15-29 years). Evidence also suggests that Youth (aged 15-29) are more prone to risky behaviours, which may lead them to HIV and other Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs).

The Red Ribbon Club (RRC) is a movement started by the Government of India to address the issues related to HIV/AIDS among the Youth, who are invariably in the age group of 15-29 years. Through RRCs, the targeted Youth are encouraged to learn about safe and healthy lifestyles. The RRCs promote and channel access to information on HIV/AIDS, further educating them about Voluntary Blood Donation and safe sexual behaviours. RRCs also aim to enable the targeted Youth to become more conscious about HIV/AIDS and related issues to further act as change agents in the HIV/AIDS programme.
