PROJECTS

1. Survey & Documentation of Ancient Manuscript of Assam

June 2005 to December 2011; Gurucharan College, Silchar

The project "Survey & Documentation of Ancient Manuscript of Assam" was carried out under the Manuscript Resource Centre, Gurucharan College, Silchar, in collaboration with the National Mission for Manuscripts, Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India. More than 12,000 rare manuscripts from 12 districts of Assam were documented and preserved.

2. Conservation of Ancient Manuscript of Assam

November 2009 to December 2011 Gurucharan College, Silchar

This project started in 2009 under the Manuscript Conservation Centre of Gurucharan College, Silchar, in collaboration with the National Mission for Manuscripts, IGNCA, Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India. More than 4000 rare manuscripts from 22 Satras (Vaisnavait Monastries) of Majuli, Assam were conserved.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF SALIENT ACHIEVEMENT

1. Creation and Augmentation of Manuscript Section at G.C. College, Silchar:

This is the new feather to the college library which was created during 2004-05. Initially library did not have a single manuscript. In 2004, a drive to collect manuscript from various sources and renowned families of Silchar was taken up by myself and by the end 1995 more than 300 old and rare manuscripts could be collected in the Library to develop the Manuscript Section. In 1995, the Manuscript Section was designated as **Manuscript Resource Centre** by the National Mission for Manuscript, IGNCA under Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India. At present the Manuscript Section has 300+ manuscripts ranging from 90 years to 300 years old, preserved in a scientific way. For information, there are two Manuscript Resource Centers in Assam; one is this at Gurucharan College Library and the other is at Gauhati University. The matter of pride for this region is that, the MRC at Gurucharan College is the only MRC at college level in entire India.

2. Reorganization of the B. C. Gupta Memorial Central Library at G.C. College, Silchar.

The total functional library space is about 14500 sq. mtr. comprising four floors with a newly constructed annex building. The ground floor houses Reading Hall, Periodical Section, Bound volume Section and Newspaper & Question Bank. Approximately 70 users can study together at a time. The first floor comprises Enquiry Cell withreprographic facilities. It also houses the Reference Section of the library. In this section all together 26 users can study together. The second floor consists of Stack Area, Circulation Section and N.E. Block. In the newly constructed N.E. Block, micro-literature of the North-East India are preserved. The third floor constitutes the Digital Library Section where, N-List, Edusat, UGC-Network Centre is housed with 16 Internet Nodes in a complete AC environment. The other part of the third floor has accommodation of Manuscript Resource Centre and Manuscript

Conservation Centre where rare books, documents are reared scientifically. Besides the Central Library, there are 22 Departmental Libraries in various departments in the college campus look after by the Central Library especially in the case of resource development.

3. Automation of the Library of the G.C. College, Silchar

The library automation programme was initiated from 12th November, 2005 by installing SOUL software in a dedicated server and the data entry operation for creating library database actually started from 3rd January, 2006 after setting up Library LAN. By the end of the session 2006-07, database of the total library volumes could be completed along with students profile and teachers' profile. The automated services like OPAC and Circulation are already in function since then.

4. Creation of Digital Library Section at the G.C. College, Silchar

The concept of a Digital Library was initiated in the year 2007 and finally it was achieved in August 2011 with a dedicated IBM Server of 2 TB capacity which is connected with the Library LAN and Campus LAN. The software TechFocuz has been used for the digital library. Soon it will be connected with the Internet for global access. It will help to develop a digital library of institutional repositories as well as born digital content. It has also a plan to digitize manuscripts and rare books in near future. Probably, this is the only college in the entire Assam to have a digital library section having its own digital server.

5. Creation of Manuscript Conservation Centre cum Laboratory at G.C. College, Silchar

Another milestone was achieved in the year 2011 when a full-fledged Manuscript Conservation Centre cum Laboratory was established in the library with the help of the National Mission for Manuscripts, New Delhi, for conservation of rare manuscripts confined to 12 districts of Assam. This Conservation Laboratory is one of its kind in India.

6. Automation of the Central Library of National Institute of Technology, Silchar

The National Institute of Technology, Silchar, invited to augment their Central Library Automation process in the year 2008. The library automation was completed in a record time of less than one year. On the 20th July 2009, Prof. P. K. Bose, the then Director of NIT Silchar, inaugurated the automated system of NIT Library. The library used LIBSYS software with RFID/DVR Technology for automation and security system.

7. Honorary assistance to various local college and school libraries.

There are many instances of providing assistance to various colleges of the region in the field of library automation and application of ICT. Some of them are Cachar College, Silchar, Silchar Medical College, Silchar, Normal School, Silchar, etc.

8. Technical guidance, assistance & training human resources for conservation of manuscripts in the Dept. of Assamese, Dibrugarh University.

The Department of Assamese of Dibrugarh University has almost 700 important manuscripts both paper and Sanchipat. Use of processed bark of Agaru or Agar tree as writing materials is an ancient method and completely endegenous to Assam. The Department of Assamese of Dibrugarh University possesses such manuscripts which are belong to late 17 Century to early 19 Century AD and was needed utmost curative as well as preventive conservation for sustainance along with scientific archiving of them. As a member of the "Committee for advising execution of the project and monitoring of the Archive", Chaired by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, DU, the responsibilities of technical guidance, assistance & training manpower resources for conservation of manuscripts in the Dept. of Assamese were entrusted upon me by the Dibrugarh University Authorities after series of discussion with the Head of the Department of Assamese on 11/02/2015. Since then, 6 persons were trained in various techniques of curative as well as preventive conservation methods for scientific preservation of the said manuscripts by me. Under my guidance, a scientific Archive cum Laboratory has been established where manuscripts are being treated and preserved by 3 trained Conservation Assistants.

9. Implimentation of Shodhganga project at Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh

It was a long time pending for Dibrugarh University to initiate implimentation of Shodhganga project of INFLIBNET Centre to upload ETD in the national repository and to digitize retrospective print thesis and dissertation of Dibrugarh University. The MOU was ultimately signed on 19/06/2015 between Dibrugarh University and INFLIBNET Centre and and the process of uploading ETDs have been started. The LNB Library, DU has already developed the ETD Lab. of its own with 4 new PCs with accessories to upload the ETDs. The scanning of the retrospective print thesis and dissertation will be started as soon as the UGC fund for the purpose is sanctioned.

10. Creation of VIDWAN Database for Experts of Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh

The creation of VIDWAN Database for Experts of Dibrugarh University who have attained 15 or more years of exerience in teaching and research is another achievement for LNB Library, DU. It was started on 27/01/2015 on urgent basis and was completed within one month which made the experts and faculty members of Dibrugarh University accessable through the national database globaly.

11. Preparation of Regulation for Plagiarism Check for Dibrugarh University, dibrugarh

Another achievement I regard for authorising me to prepare the **Regulation for Plagiarism Check for Dibrugarh University** by the Dean's Meeting on 29/04/2016 with Hon'ble Vice Chancellor's due approval. The draft regulation for the University was prepared with due care and concern keeping view of all pros and cons after intense study on the subject adhered in various famous universities of the world, like Oxford University, Cambridge University, Masachuset Institute of Technology, etc. This draft regulation is already approved and implemented after due scrutiny by the Executive Council of Dibrugarh University and is being used for plagiarism check of theses and other research outputs of the research scholars and faculty members.

12. Installation and activation of anti-plagiarism software at Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh

Another landmark achievement is implimentation of checking of research outputs, such as thesis, dissertations, project reports, articles and other scholarly contents of Dibrugarh University through anti-plagiarism software URKUND with effect from 16/05/2016. This anti plagiarism software was a long demand of the faculty members and research scholars of the University.

13. Initiatives for development of Digital Library/Institutional Repository at Dibrugarh University

There has been a constant effort to develop a Digital Library/Institutional Repository for Dibrugarh University since my joining using DSpace, an open source software. Tremendous progress has been made in this regard with already custimized webpage as DUIR with a link http://10.100.25.100/jspui and the Institutional Repository is likely to be functional at the end of this year.

14. Installation of specialized software (JAWS & Open Book) and other Hardware in the Visually Impaired Section for users with Visual Impairment/Vision Impairment/Vision Disability

Another landmark achievement is installation of specialized software (JAWS & Open Book) and hardware scanners, digital camera and other audio devices for users with Visual Impairment/Vision Impairment/Vision Disability for the first time in the University. Two software, namely JAWS & OpenBook has been installed in 3 PCs along with special scanners like Sara CE, Pearl Scanner, loaded with Topaz machaine feed with Magic software and Wynn Literacy helping for reading with magnification upto 10x level. Though the Centre started functioning from 16 August 2016, it was inaugurated formally by Dr. Renuka Mishra, Director, MHRD, GoI.

15. Augmentation of Virtual Environment of LNB Library of Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh.

The moden day academic library, especially University Library has to fulfill varried satisfaction of varried nature to a wide range of users. Application of ICT in information storage & management, information generation, information dessimination and information access has been a pivotal aspect of modern university library. The LNB Library of Dibrugarh University is no exception to this. There has been a constant effort to augment the virtual environment of the LNB Library since my joining as Deputy Librarian by implimenting various ICT related projects, and installing different kind of software to fulfill the objectives in that directions. For example, upgradation of ILMS Soul-2.0 to SOUL3.0 with the provision of Web-OPAC for bibliographic library database search from anywhere, off campus or in campus of the university; provision of **IndCat** to search bibliographic database of books and thesis incorporated in the Indian Union Catalogue developed by INFLIBNET Centre from more than 189 Indian Universities; new provision for federated search of subscribed and consortium offered e-resource witth discovery services through Ebsco host and remote access services of these resources through world class search tool OpenAthens will surely enhance usages of online resources; use of indexing tool like Scopus for citation of peer reviewed articles and journals and calculation of H-index, both individual and institutional is positively a step forward for achieving electronic environment; awareness for use of open sources of scholarly contents provided especially by NMEICT, Sakshat, NPTEL, CEC, NDL, e-PG Pathshala, e-Acharya, DOAJ, OAL, OAPEN, OAJSE including Shodhganga; subscription of 2,00,000+ e-books from EBESCO, Elsevier, Tailor & Frensis, Cambridge University Press is another significant events in respect to its unconventional mode of collection development; installation of specialized software (JAWS & OpenBook) and hardware (Topaz, Angel, Braille) for users with Visual Impairment/Vision Impairment/Vision Disability is another signicficant development to encompass physically challanged users in the embient of virtual Library. To enhance and facilitate the research activities in the university online tool like SAGE Research Methods, anti-plagiarism software (PDS) like URKUND/OURIGINAL, etc have been sibscribed/installed and have been made available through library webportal for all students, research scholars and faculty members.

The summary of other salient achievements of the 24 years of occupation are conducting **Exhibition/workshops**, **Public Awareness Programmes**, **Students & RS Orientation Programme**, **Book Reviews** for the library user to create awareness for maximum Utility of library resources, **Staff's Training** and **Orientation Programme** for ability enhancement to handle modern technology and ICT related activities in the library.
