

Dibrugarh University is a premier institution of higher education. The University is the second oldest University in Assam, which was established as a State Affiliating University in 1965. It is located on the southern bank of mighty river Brahmaputra in the north-eastern part of India. HOW TO REACH DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY:

Dibrugarh can be reached by Road, Rail and Air.

- By Air: The Mohanbari Airport is located at a distance of 23 kms. from the Dibrugarh University. Several Airlines Operate daily flights to and from Dibrugarh from all major cities of India.
- By Road: The Dibrugarh bus station is located at a distance of 5 kms from the Dibrugarh University.
- By Rail: The DBRT and DBRG Railway Station are located at a distance of 5 Kms and 10 Kms respectively from Dibrugarh University.
- Climate of Dibrugarh: The climate of Dibrugarh is very pleasant during the month of February when the temperature varies within 18°C - 23°C. The participants are advised to bring necessary clothings suitable for the climate.
