

AWARENESS CAMPAIGN AT TETELIGURI AND KALGHAR OF DIHINGMUKH IN SIVASAGAR DISTRICT ON 10TH FEBRUARY, 2024



On February 10th, Saturday, the M.A. 4th semester students from the Centre for Studies in Geography was engaged in community service initiatives in the villages of Teteliguri and Kalghar of Dihingmukh in Sivasagar District.
