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ADMISSION MODALITIES FOR ADMISSION TO THE FIVE-YEAR INTEGRATED POST GRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYIPGP) FOR THE 2024-2025 SESSION

1. For admission to the Five-Year Integrated Post Graduate Programme (FYIPGP) of Dibrugarh University, the following two criteria shall be followed:

Criterion 1(a):

50% of the total seats in each Department/Centre of Dibrugarh University shall be filled up based on the performance of the candidates in the **Common University Entrance Test for Under Graduate (CUET-UG)** programmes in the relevant discipline conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA).

A minimum of 60% aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination for General Category and 55% aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination for the SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD candidates will be considered as eligibility criterion.

In case of admission under criterion 1(a), allotment of Major will be done only on the basis of CUET UG score, provided, preference will be given to candidates having the subject in the (10+2) examination. *However, for the candidates opting for the below mentioned programmes, preference will be given in allotment of Major as per the following details:*

- (a) For FYIPGP in Commerce, preference will be given to candidates having Accountancy/Business Studies as one of the subjects in the 10+2 examination.
- (b) For FYIPGP in Life Sciences (Botany) and FYIPGP in Life Sciences (Zoology), preference will be given to candidates having Biology as one of the subjects in the 10+2 examination.
- (c) For FYIPGP in Statistics, preference will be given to candidates having Mathematics/Statistics/Applied Mathematics as one of the subjects in the 10+2 examination.

Criterion 1(b):

Remaining 50% of the seats in each Department/Centre of Dibrugarh University shall be filled up **on the basis of merit** in the (10+2) examination conducted by the recognized boards as per clause 2 below.

Under this criterion,

- i) A minimum of 60% aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination for General Category and 55% aggregate percentage of marks or equivalent grade in (10+2) examination for the SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD candidates will be considered as eligibility criterion.
 - ii) In the allotment of/admission to a Major, preference will be given to candidates having the subject in the (10+2) examination.
2. Under criterion 1(b),
- (a) In case of two or more candidates securing an equal percentage of marks in the (10+2) examination in the subject opting for Major, the candidate securing higher aggregate percentage of marks or grade in the (10+2) examination shall be ranked higher in the allotment of Major.
 - (b) In case of two or more candidates securing equal percentage of marks in the (10+2) examination in the subject opting for Major as well as equal aggregate percentage of marks in the (10+2) examination, the candidates securing higher aggregate percentage of marks/grade in class 10 shall be ranked higher in the allotment of Major in the subject.
 - (c) In case of seats remaining vacant after admission of students, a candidate without having the concerned subject in (10+2) examination shall be admitted to a major course based on the aggregate percentage of marks in the (10+2) examination.
3. If any seat remains vacant under either of the above two criteria [1(a) or 1(b)], the same may be filled from the eligible candidates from the other criterion.
4. If a candidate is eligible for admission into a programme under both criteria 1(a) and 1(b), he/she shall be admitted through criterion 1(a) only.
5. For any matter not covered by the above clauses, the decision of the Competent Authority shall be final and binding.
