Procedure for Enrolment of Generic Elective Courses (GECs) for the 3rd Semester / 9th Semester Students of the Post Graduate/Integrated M.Sc. in Physics Programmes of Dibrugarh University

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The enrolment to the GECs shall be done on *First Come First Serve* basis by an automated system through the ERP portal. *The online enrolment process will start on 10.07.2024 at 6.00 p.m. and end on 24.07.2024 at 11.59 p.m.*

The 3rd semester / 9th Semester students who are required to enroll for GE are advised to check their student account at the ERP portal by login to the URL <https://erp.dibru.work> before 10.07.2024 by following the below mentioned instructions:

Checking the account before enrolment process begins:

1. Go to "Student Login"(ERP) and Login to your account with your registered mobile number and password.
2. If you have forgotten your password, you can reset it by going through "Forgot your password" link given below the "Login" button.
3. After login if you don't see the name of your programme under "My Programmes" section on the Dashboard, it implies that you are not using the correct registered mobile number.
4. If you still cannot figure out your registered mobile number, contact the office assistant of your Department/Centre.
5. After successful login, check your Semester on the Dashboard whether it is correct or not. If you find any discrepancy, contact the Office Assistant of your Department/Centre for necessary correction.
6. If you find any discrepancy or difficulty in login, you may send a mail to admissionsupport@dibru.ac.in before 5.00 p.m. of 10.07.2024.

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How to apply for GE enrolment

1. Login to your account on *10.07.2024 around 6.00 p.m.*
2. On the Dashboard under “My Programmes” section, you will see a link “Select GE”. (if you don’t see this link even after 6.00 p.m. on *10.07.2024*, refresh the browser).
3. A list of GE offered by various departments/centres will be displayed along with their intake and remaining seats. Click the “Apply” button corresponding to your desired GE. You can apply only one GE. After confirming, you will be automatically get registered/enrolled if seats are available. *Please note that availability of seats will be determined by the system dynamically at runtime. So, even if you see there are some seats vacant, before clicking the “Apply” button, there may be many students who are simultaneously clicking the “Apply” button and thus the system will allot the seats on first come first serve basis even considering microsecond difference.*
4. You will be able to download a registration slip if your enrolment is successful.
