- ➤ The candidates shall have to be physically present in the Centre for Studies in Applied Psychology, Dibrugarh University, on 19th of August, 2024, as per the scheduled time for counseling/verification of their documents.
- ➤ The merit of the students who have secured the same score in DUPGET 2024 shall be determined on the basis of marks secured in the B.A./B.Sc., or Class 12th/10th Examinations.
- ➤ The candidates provisionally selected for admission (under any category) shall have to bring the following documents on the date of admission:

- 01) A print copy of the Online Application submitted along with the photocopies of all relevant testimonials
- 02) DUPGET 2024 Score Card
- 03) All documents in **original** for producing before the Admission Committee.
 - a. HSLC Admit Card
 - b. Mark-sheets of Examinations passed (HSLC, HS, Degree all semesters)
 - c. Pass certificates of Examinations passed (HSLC, HS, Degree)
 - d. Degree Registration Card
- 04) Caste Certificate (if selected under any of the statutory reserved categories)
- Non-Creamy Layer Certificate: Candidates seeeking admission under the category of OBC/MOBC must produce NON-CREAMY LAYER valid certificate from the concerned Circle Officer if the parents/guardians of candidates are agriculturists. If the parents/guardians of candidates are retired/salaried then Income Certificate from the concerned controlling Authority/Treasury Officer is to be submitted.
 - * In case of inability to produce the NCL Certificate, a copy of the application of the NCL Certificate will be considered for admission. However, the hardcopy of the NCL Certificate must be produced within 15 days from the date of admission, failing which the seat of the candidate will be cancelled and the next eligible candidate will be considered for admission.
- 06) **Domicile Certificate/Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC)** of Assam for availing the Fee waiver benefit.
- 07) **EWS Certificate (if applicable)**

- 09) Undertaking of **'Provisional Admission'** (Format of Undertaking is available in the DU website)
- 10) **Gap Certificate:** If there is a gap of minimum two years from the completion of the last programme of Study, a Gap Certificate must be produced in the form of an Affidavit for consideration of admission.
- 11) *The Admission Fee, Course Fee, etc.* (wherever applicable) is to be paid by the candidates at the time of admission through *online mode.*
- 12) The Selection and Admission of the Programme covered by this Notification shall be purely provisional and subject to fulfillment of requisite norms of Qualifying examination and other relevant criteria.
- 13) Anti-Ragging Declaration: Admitted students are directed to submit the ANTI-RAGGING undertakings online in the website http://www.antiragging.in (as per the Circular issued by the UGC, vide no. D.O.F. No. 1-15/2009(ARC) PT.III, dated 12th June, 2023).
