ANNEXURE - I

SOP on Bhaxa Gaurav Saptah for Universities and Colleges

- 1. Bhaxa Gaurav Saptah to be celebrated from 03rd to 09th November, 2024 in Colleges/Universities. This is an opportunity to celebrate the languages of Assam.
- 2. All Universities and Colleges are requested strictly to adhere to the linguistic sensibilities of the area. The sentiments of students should not be hurt in any way.
- 3. Discussion on evolution of Assamese and other languages of Assam. Seminars and Symposiums to be held on this topic.
- 4. Discussion on phonology of Assamese and other languages of Assam. Spelling contests to be organized amongst the students.
- 5. Seminars or lecture programmes on the history and development of Assamese literature and literature of other languages of Assam.
- 6. Discussion on the contemporary litterateurs of Assamese literature and other literature and languages of Assam. Importance should be given to organizing reading sessions of contemporary dramas, poetry short stories and so on.
- To organize and help students to perform skills, street plays and one act plays or extracts from the celebrated and popular dramas written in Assamese language and other languages of Assam.
